**NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATIONS OF
THE GREEN HYDROGEN COALITION**

In accordance with Rule 8.4 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), the Green Hydrogen Coalition (“GHC”) hereby submit this notice of ex parte communication. The teleconference meeting lasted approximately 35 minutes and was held on Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at 2:00 PM PT with Sean Simon, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Clifford Rechtschaffen, Simi George, Advisor to Commissioner Rechtschaffen, and Jason Reiger, Interim Legal and Policy Advisor at the Commission. The GHC representatives in attendance were Janice Lin, Founder and President of the GHC, Nicholas Connell, Policy Director of the GHC, and Hope Fasching, Policy Analyst of the GHC. All communications were oral; no written materials were shared.

Mrs. Lin began the meeting by introducing Mr. Connell and Ms. Fasching and then provided background about the GHC and GHC’s vision for a green hydrogen economy in California (this included findings from HyBuild LA efforts). Mrs. Lin and Mr. Connell discussed the opportunities green hydrogen brings to California, such as jobs, reduced fossil fuel dependence, energy security, and decarbonization. Mrs. Lin and Mr. Connell commended the Commission on its proposed decision (PD) and provided feedback regarding the proposed clean hydrogen definition, specifically around the importance of a carbon intensity framework. Mrs. Lin concluded the

meeting by emphasizing how important the Angeles Link Project is for California and that the time to do this work is now.
